

What is a Challenge Team?

A Challenge Team is a group of young adults who visit secondary schools across the UK making presentations to pupils in Years 9 and above with an hour long fun, interactive and fast moving presentation. Knowledge of reproduction and contraception is assumed. The Team discusses sex and relationships and explains the benefits of delaying sexual activity. The speakers talk frankly, modestly and respectfully, covering such topics as STIs, teen pregnancy, drugs and alcohol, pornography and sexting, the media, image and peer pressure, friendships, forming attachments, relationships and marriage.

To date Challenge Team has spoken to well over 150,000 teens across the UK. The presentation has no religious references or moral overtones and is suited to pupils whatever their sexual orientation or family background.

As an alternative to a live performance, a DVD of the presentation is available for purchase.

Challenge Team UK aims to:

- Raise aspirations, confidence and self-esteem
- Encourage sexual respect for self and all others
- Educate pupils regarding the influence of media on fashion and image
- Explain the nature of marriage, friendship and commitment
- Help pupils to understand the potential short term and long term risks of early sexual activity
- Equip those who feel under pressure to have sex to resist such pressure
- Give pupils the opportunity to hear that saving sex is both possible and has many benefits
- Use young adult role models to counteract the influence of the prevailing celebrity culture
- Enable pupils to make their own well-informed choices with regard to sex and relationships
